

Parking – Information Sheet

Parking in Oxford is a nightmare, worse than London. This sheet has been compiled to help you find the best option.

Pay and Display Parking – Streets in the vicinity of College

There are a good number of parking bays with Pay and Display machines in the streets around College and charges, revised in January 2007, are set out below.

After 6.30pm there is no charge no ticket required

Parking for Disabled

Unlimited Parking is permissible free of charge in Pay and Display and in Residents' Parking bays of which there are many in Museum, Blackwell and Keble Roads, if Disabled Badge is clearly displayed.

It is permissible to park on Double Yellow lines (not Loading areas) for a maximum of 3 hours only provided it is a safe place; Keble, Blackwell or Museum Roads, but not Parks Road, and the Disabled Badge is clearly displayed.

On Street Parking – North Oxford

Parking in the residential streets north of College and north of Park Town (on the Banbury Road) is now with **Residents' Parking Permits only**.

Park and Ride

There are 5 Park and Ride schemes around Oxford, at the four compass points, with two to the north. These are well sign posted from the main approach roads to Oxford. The cost of leaving a car is 60p per 24 hours and it is possible to buy 2 or more tickets if planning to park for longer. Buses run frequently (10 -15 minutes during the day and every 20-30 minutes in the evenings) to and from the centre up until about 6.30pm and then every 30 minutes. The last buses to each of the Park & Rides leave the centre of Oxford about 11.15pm. There is a charge of £2 for a return bus ticket to the city centre but after 4pm this is reduced to £1.50. It is strongly advised **to hide any valuables from view** and park near site offices or bus terminals where lighting is good. Peartree (north), **Redbridge** (south) and **Seacourt** (west) are operated by the City Council Tel: 01865 794307. The car parks have officers on duty between 7am and 11.15pm. (the time of arrival of the last bus).

Thornhill (east) and **Water Eaton** (north) are operated by the County Council Tel: 01865 815649. These car parks have 24 hour security cameras and officers are on duty from early morning until about 11.20pm. At Thornhill (Site Office Tel: 01865 744 810) it is advised to park at the new well lit area on the right hand side. Water Eaton has no Park & Ride buses operating on a Sunday or after 7pm but the Kidlington buses (Nos 2, 2a) stop outside.

Secure Locked Parking

Gloucester Green car park (off Beaumont Street) is locked and secure from 12am until 7.15am. Parking Permits should be obtained in advance from 01865 252489 at a cost of £25.70 for 24 hours.

Other City Car parks

Westgate Multi-storey

Payment is on exit either at the control office which is open on a Sundays or ticket machine. Charges are by the hour and it is possible to park overnight at a cost of £23 for 24 hours. For information please call 01865 252489.

Worcester Street

Parking by pre-bought ticket at machine for limited time.
